THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE KINGSTON TENNIS CLUB, BUT
ARE AFRAID TO ASK...

Hours of Operation

- . club hours are between 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 p.m. daily April 24 to September 6
- . courts may not be available during: social evenings (usually Thursday or Friday), tournaments (generally weekends), Doubles League (Tuesday evenings)
- . after Labour Day members can book from 4:30 - 10:30 p.m.
- . Club usually remains opens until Thanksgiving

Playing Times

- . duration of play: 1 hour for singles games, 2 hours for doubles games
- . change is on the half-hour
- . there are no bells to indicate time; please be courteous and leave the court at the appointed time

Booking Rules

- . there are no court fees
- . courts can be booked up to one week in advance; one booking per day
- . stewards will take bookings in person anytime after 8:30 a.m. and until 10:30 p.m.
- . stewards may be available to take bookings by phone after 2 p.m.
- . stewards will be available to take phone booking between 8:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m.
- . last booking time in the evening is 9:30 p.m.

Club House

- . juice, soft drinks, chips and chocolate bars as well as balls, free demonstration racquets, and tennis club shirts are available upstairs
- . shower, washroom, change room available downstairs
- . relax and watch others play from the balcony or deck
- . racquet stringing is available

Dress Code

- . KTC has no dress code; comfortable, appropriate clothing is best
- . shoes with black soles and street shoes are not permitted on the courts

Retrieving Balls

- . ask a steward to retrieve balls that are hit into resident's yards
- . residents prefer to have stewards retrieve balls rather than players

Shoe Tags

- . pick up your shoe tags at the club house after opening day
- . members are asked to wear their shoe tags while playing

Tennis Lessons

- . OTA certified professional is available for group and private lessons
- . group lessons are available for beginners, intermediates and juniors twice a week for 3 weeks
- . minimal cost; reserve your spot early

Leagues

- . sign up with the stewards for singles and doubles leagues for all level of players
- . singles: you will get a list of names and numbers of players at your level and you must arrange games with each of the players on your list
- . doubles: you will receive a schedule of Tuesday nights your team is playing games are arranged over a 5-week period
there is a small fee to cover the cost of balls
popular so sign up early; a substitute list is kept

Socials

- . every month watch for posters advertising the date of social tennis evenings
- . sign up with the stewards; there is no need to bring a partner
- . doubles games will be organized for you regardless of your level of play
- . there is a small fee to cover our costs: balls, food and drinks after tennis

Junior Camp

- . camp offered in July and August from 10:30 - 12:00 noon
- . one-week sessions for a modest fee
- . ages 6 to 17

Guest Coupon

- . KTC welcomes visitors from out of town, or non-members
- . use the coupon to bring a guest; there is a court fee for visitors/non members
- . Kingston guests limited to 3 visits

Cooperative Non-Profit Organization

- . Queen's owns the facilities and the club pays rent
- . members of the Executive are volunteers; please feel free to contact:

- . there is an Annual General Meeting at the end of the season; all members are encouraged to attend
