Junior Drop-Ins

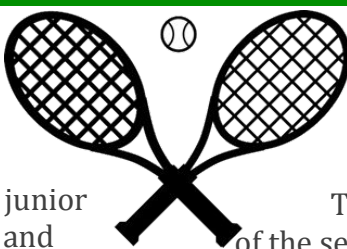

Recycling at KTC



There are several recycling options available at the club:

For the safety of all club members, due to their sharp edges, all metal can lids should be placed in the recycling bin.

3. Plastic and Paper products - placed in their respective bin.
