Juniors will meet at the end of their Round Robin on May 24th, to elect a Junior Executive. This will be a chance for Juniors to help organize the kind of program they want. Make sure you turn out. No pre-registration is necessary for either of these days.

2. Eastern Ontario Championships: Saturday and Sunday, June 21st and 22nd.

This is an O.L.T.A. sanctioned tournament and a big registration is expected. The Tournament Committee, under the co-chairmanship of Bernie Houghton and Gary Quinn is already at work with plans to make this a tournament we can be proud of. further details. Watch the bulletin board and get your name on the ladders.


7. Juniors
