3rd Annual Fundraising Clinics

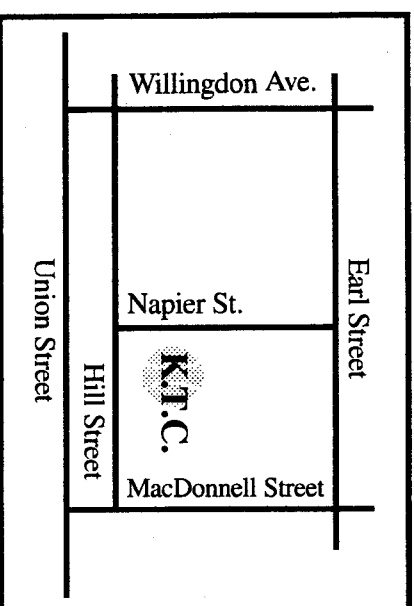
This is your chance to support your club while improving your tennis. For the third year, head pro Tony Roth will offer tennis clinics and donate the proceeds towards court maintenance.

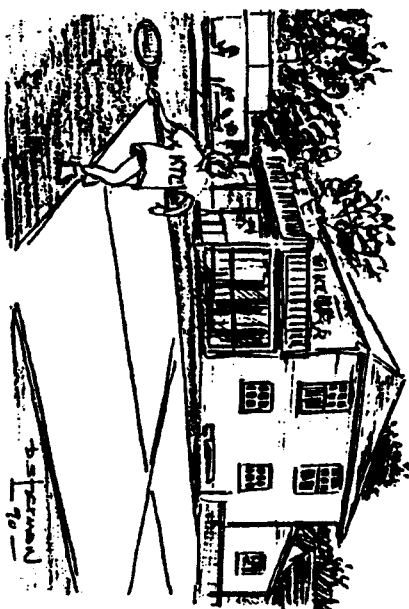

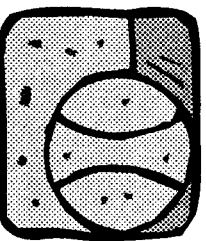
